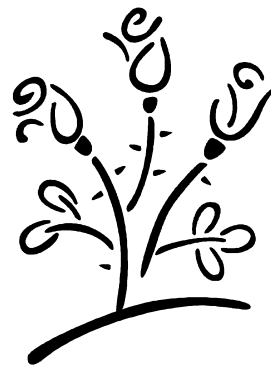

- ***Leave stems as long as possible. They can be cut to size after being entered.***
- ***Judging is on perfection of flower, straightness, freshness and freedom from insect infestation.***
- ***Containers supplied by Steward, unless otherwise specified.***
- ***Roses- leave some foliage on but no buds.***
- ***Stem-can have one or more multiple flowers***
